## Historic Categories of Funding

ENVIRONMENTAL SUPPORTS

PACT'S ENVIRONMENTAL SUPPORT GRANTS PROVIDE FUNDING TO COMMUNITY BASED GROUPS. MAXIMUM FUNDING ALLOTMENT IS BZ\$10,000



**EXTRAORDINARY FUNDING:** 

THESE GRANT TYPES REFER TO ANY REQUEST OUTSIDE OF THE INVESTMENT/GRANT CYCLE. AN EXTRAORDINARY FUNDING REQUEST MUST BE FOR A PERIOD OF NO MORE THAN ONE YEAR (12 MONTHS)

50% OF PACT'S REVENUE IS DERIVED FROM THE PACT CONSERVATION FEE PAID BY VISITORS WHEN THEY DEPART FROM BELIZE

SINGLE CATEGORY GRANT:

AVAILABLE TO A SINGLE APPLICANT WITH A MAXIMUM FUNDING ENVELOPE OF BZ\$100,00




