FINANCE GAP

Implementing the Philippine Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (PBSAP) from 2015 to 2028 requires \$530M/year. However, the projected biodiversity expenditure of the government only amounts to \$110M/year.



How is BIOFIN Philippines reducing the gap?
By piloting several finance solutions such as mainstreaming the PBSAP into government plans and programs.
