




Findings and Recommendations

Suggestion 1



The first one involves utilizing the government's role in financial support, such as increasing fiscal investment; establishing efficient, diverse ecological compensation mechanisms; improving the green tax system; improving the efficiency of the use of government funding; scaling up Nature-based green infrastructure; optimizing existing agricultural subsidy policies; bettering existing fishery subsidy policies; carrying out ecosystem servicing and GDP accounting.

Suggestion 2



The second one involves developing and improving market-based finance mechanisms for ecological conservation and restoration, such as expanding mechanisms for realizing the value of ecological products; working out Nature-based climate solutions; developing green finance; strengthening biodiversity risk prevention and control at financial institutions; encouraging and mobilizing social capital and charitable funds.
