Reforestation plan 2023-2030



Main activity: facilitation of natural regeneration processes (full or partial fencing of a land (area) to be reforested, protecting new shoots and/or regrowth from grazing, cleaning soil from undergrowth within a fenced area, and removing grass and loosening soil in order to facilitate natural seeding)



Forests of Georgia

- 44.5% (3,096,700 ha) of Georgian territory is covered by forests
- At least 95% of Georgian forests are natural
- Pristine forests represent around 500,000 ha
