- Small Funding basket from conservation funds that target small scale activities.

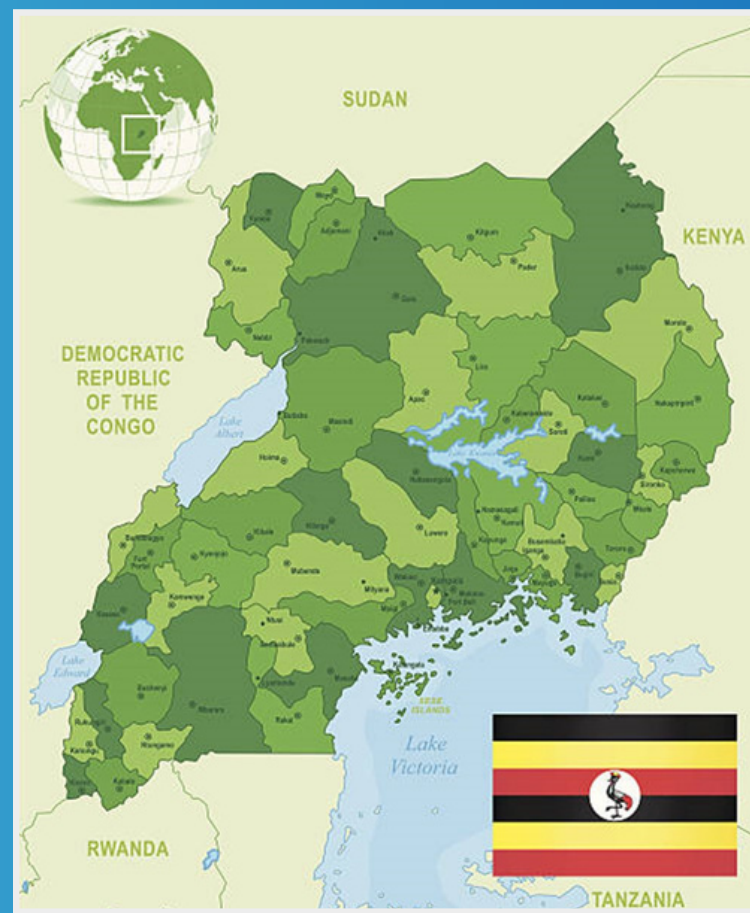
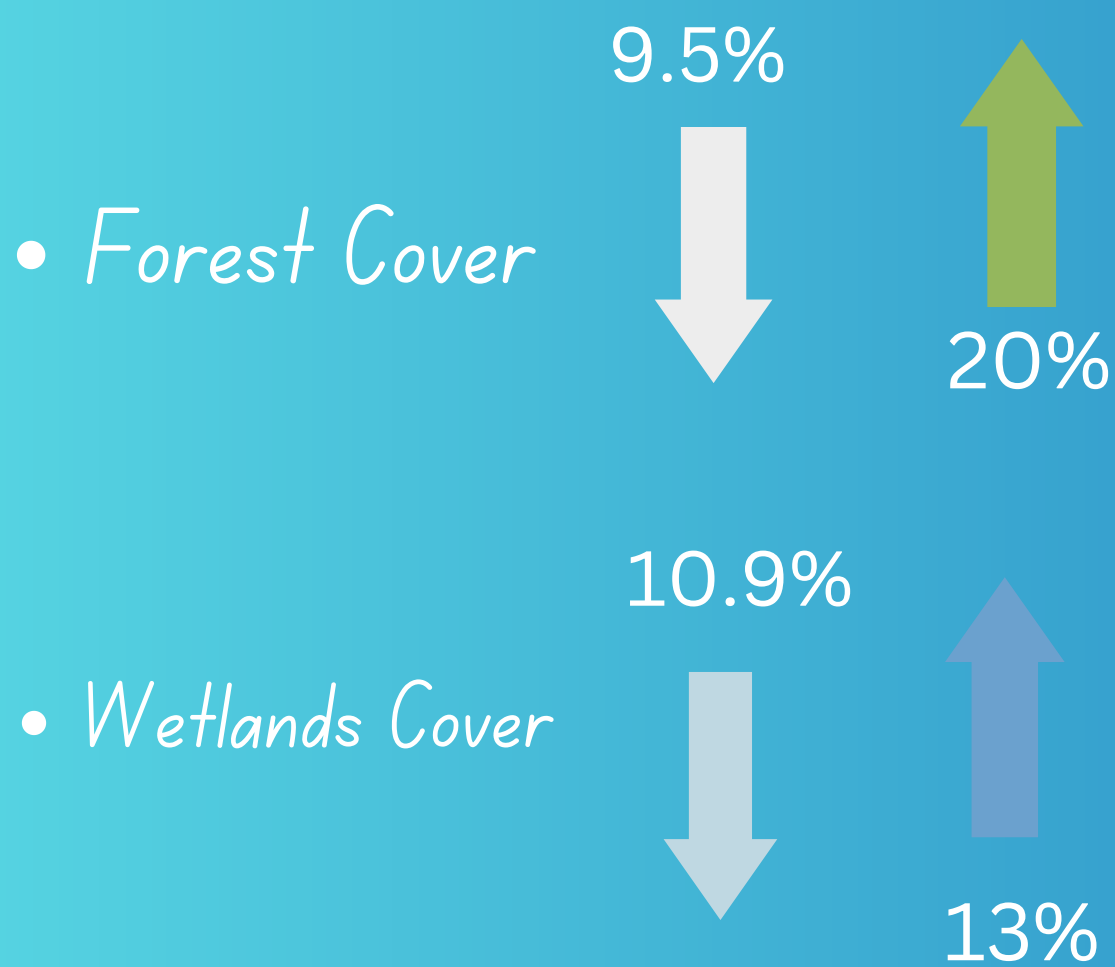
Stakeholders

Finance Solutions

- A national biodiversity Ecosystem and biodiversity fiscal transfers.
- Scaling up bottom-up enforcement for biodiversity and ecosystem management based on community regulatory systems and incentive model.

Interpretation

- Forest Cover declined from 20% in 1986/87 to 9.5% in 2017/18 while wetland cover reduced from 13% to 10.9% over the same time.
- Currently, forest cover is 13% and wetland cover increased to slightly above 11%.

- Decentralize Decision Making.
- Promote Equal Fiscal Distribution.
